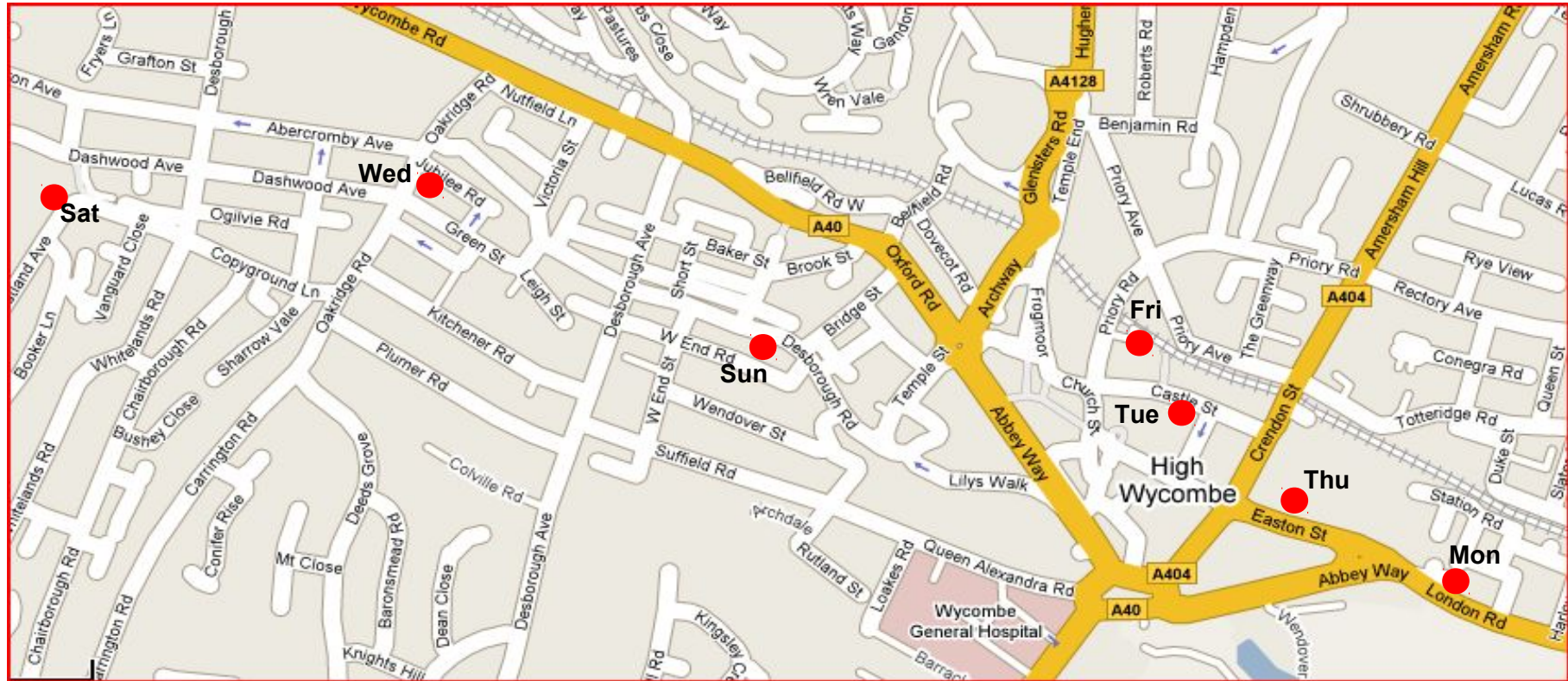




Wycombe Winter Night Shelter Venues



Sunday Night	West End Hall, Kings Church	Entrance on West End Road off Desborough Road
Monday Night	Trinity United Reformed Church	Opposite the Rye, on the London Road next to the pedestrian crossing
Tuesday Night	Oakley Hall, All Saints' Church	Castle Street Coffee Shop entrance
Wednesday Night	Oakridge Baptist Church	Oakridge Road
Thursday Night	Union Baptist Church, The HUB	Easton Street one way system
Friday Night	Wesley Methodist Church	Priory Road opposite side entrance of Primark near railway arch
Saturday Night	St. Mary's & St. George's Church	Top of steps off Dashwood Avenue or Rutland Avenue corner

The Shelter uses a different venue each night and is staffed mainly by volunteers from 30+ churches and is aimed at helping people forward. There is a behaviour code and a disclosure policy that must be agreed to. There is NO admission without prior arrangement. This is primarily through Wycombe District Council Homelessness Department (Monday - Friday, daytime 9am - 3pm). In person, not by telephone. The Shelter is not operated by WDC but is supported by them, the Bucks Drug & Alcohol Action Team, the Old Tea Warehouse hostel, Probation Service, the JobCentre and the Police.
